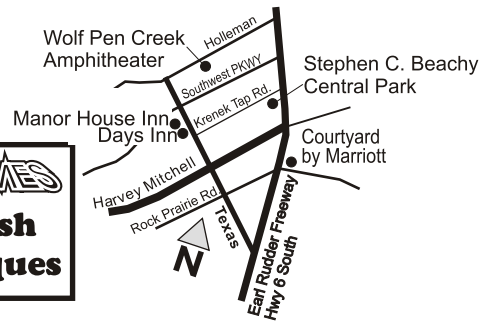

Rules for **Rat Rod** Drawing

1. Must have a registered car at the 18th EVER Rod Run June 13-14 2009 and purchase a \$10.00 drawing ticket.
2. Must be present at the Awards ceremony to win.
3. Must be 18 or older and have a valid drivers license.
4. Winner must sign a waiver of liability.
5. Winner is responsible for transportation of car. (Car can be picked up later with appointment)
6. Bluebonnet Street Rod club members and immediate family are not eligible to win.
7. Note: In the event that the winner of the car wants to donate the car to be auctioned off. All auction proceeds will be donated to Still Creek Ranch.
If the car is auctioned, anyone 18 or older with a valid drivers licence, including Bluebonnet Street Rod club members will be eligible to bid.
(The drawing winner will be given a tax-deductible receipt for the sale price.)
